To do before you leave

Clothes

- Hat/headband & scarf
- Ski gloves & regular gloves

Equipment

- Ski shoes, skis & ski poles
- Ski helmet
- Ski straps
- Ski goggles & sunglasses

To do before you hit the slopes

- Have a complete breakfast
- Apply sunscreen & lip balm
- Take the booking confirmation with you
- Pick up your course card
- Pick up your rental equipment
- Buy your ski pass
- Get a map of the slopes
- Get to the meeting point in time
